Report of Special Meeting, 16th October - Chairman Claire Marr

This verbal report, concerned a development proposal for a neighbourhood centre (including retail) at a site in Thorntonhall.

Stuart MacGarvie (SG), a Planning Consultant, acting on behalf of a local landowner, had made a presentation to a special sub-committee group of the Community Council on October 16th. At this stage, no decision has been made by the landowner on whether to submit a planning application. The sub-committee agreed to pass the information to the main Community Council for public discussion.

The site location lies to the north end of Peel Road, Thorntonhall and is situated between Bystone Cottage and White Gables (see attached location plan). The site is one acre and

was formerly used for equestrian purposes. Hedging has been removed from the roadside boundary.

SG gave details of the potential layout and uses which included retail, business, and possible community uses such as nursery, medical and community use, alongwith parking.

Reference was made to the National Planning Framework 4 and the concept of neighbourhood facilities within 20 minutes walking distance.

The main public comments were:

- The selected area is greenspace, the horse-riding ring forming only a corner of the planned area.
- Speeding and increased traffic on Peel Road is an ongoing problem, the addition of a retail facility in the planned location would encourage more traffic from outside the village.
- Concern that the introduction of a neighbourhood complex in this location would accelerate adjacent house development.

Further debate would take place when a planning application is forthcoming.

Redwood Crescent closed between A726 and number 1 Redwood Crescent from Tuesday 14 November to Friday 17 November for telecom pole installation. Diversion via A726.

Park Drive is closed between Thornton Road and Wellknowe Avenue from Monday 20 November to Friday 24 November for maintenance works. Diversion via Wellknowe Avenue, Wellknowe Road, Braehead Road and Thornton Road.

Peel Road closed between Gilmour Avenue and the train station access from Monday 27 November to Friday 1 December for telecom repairs. Diversion via B764 Eaglesham Road, A726 Queensway and A727 East Kilbride Road.

Thornton Road is closed between Peel Road and Thornton Farm from Monday 11 December to Tuesday 9 April 2024 to replace the railway bridge. Diversion via Peel Road and Braehead Road.

Flooding and Raw sewage on Eaglesham Road.

A recurring problem on Eaglesham Road, Jackton, northwest of the Police College. During times of high rainfall, the main sewer from Lindsayfield to Jackton, appears to be overwhelmed and the manhole covers have dirty water gushing out of them. While there is a recently excavated 'suds pond' on the opposite side of the road, it does not prevent the road being flooded. The 'overtopping' of the sewer manholes may be linked to large residential developments between Jackton and Lindsayfield. Complaints have been made in the past. Scottish Water and SEPA will be contacted to see if a resolution can be found.

Thorntonhall History Talk

Susan Hunter Field Archaeologist and her volunteer team have recently completed their research on the History of Thorntonhall and surrounding areas. They have been field walking and surveying the local farmlands and houses. She has agreed to come to a meeting in the New Year and give a talk on the industrial and social history of the area and interesting historical facts uncovered.

Verge issue Braehead Road

With the hedges and verges overgrown, a car sustained wheel damage on a hidden roadside boulder. The location was Braehead Road close to the junction with Thornton Road. The car driver had pulled into the side to avoid an oncoming car. The issues are hedge and verge maintenance plus the presence of a boulder.

CC response - the location will be investigated and Roads Department informed.

Note: the hedges around and within the village were cut back last week.

Blocked Drains

Several drains around the village are blocked and need to be cleaned before the winter to prevent flooding.

Busby Road traffic issues.

Busby Road seems to have continuous road works causing long traffic queues on the East Kilbride Road. Can the CC include roadworks for this location in the minutes. Cllr Williams added that temporary traffic lights do not require the prior notification.

CC response – Busby Road is in East Renfrewshire. The secretary will contact ER Council and ask to be added to their emailing list for roadworks.

Micro Grant Funds

The community council has funds available in the Renewable Energy Fund Micro Grants Scheme. Grants up to a maximum of £500 are available to individuals, groups or organisations who need small amounts to pursue their objectives.

Applications can be accepted from groups including those who don't have a written constitution or set of rules.

Individuals must be living in the eligible Community Council areas to which they apply.
